About Project

- We shall build homes for 202 Roma families in Belgrade
- Resettlement procedures and processes that are fully in line with the international human rights standards will be established
- The construction of new houses will be complemented with the activities that will grant the beneficiaries access to health, education, social protection, employment, justice and human rights protection.

The European Union has allocated 3.6 milion Euros for implementation of the project. The City of Belgrade will provide urban planning documentation, approve the technical documentation and issue permits and infrastructure connections to utility networks.

Locations of the new homes

Adequate housing criteria imply that locations must provide certain conditions: access to employment options, health-care services, schools, child-care centres and other social facilities.

Priority will be given to locations with better opportunities to generate income.

We respect basic human rights of all people, including the right not to be discriminated. This project will offer necessary empowerment to Roma families so that they can upgrade the quality of their life in line with the upgrade in the living standards that this project brings.











The Project is implemented by the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS), in partnership with the City of Belgrade, the Office of the High Commission for Human Rights (OHCHR), Danish Refugee Council, Housing Development Centre for Socially Vulnerable Groups and the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE).

All people have the right to adequate housing.



Implementation Step by Step

- Select locations for construction that have adequate planning. and technical conditions
- Consult families about locations and housing options
- Construct multi-family blocks, reconstruct private and village houses
- All construction will follow the standards of sustainble infrastructure.
- Improve infrastructure conditions in the receiving communities
- Support drafting legal documents for ownership, maintenance and security of tenure
- Prepare the relocation schedule and assistance plan.
- Organise resettlement and give support to the families during the whole process.

The project was designed to ensure participation of Roma men, women and families throughout its implementation. The beneficiaries will take an active role in the process of defining the conceptual design of the accommodations, in designing the rules of the distribution of accommodation, in definition of the rules of co-habitation in the multi-family blocks.
