1	With reference to the above- mentioned procurement notice I am writing to inquire about my organization's eligibility to apply to implement said project. We are a small women-owned organization incorporated in Washington, DC in the United States. From your published notice, it seems like only organizations incorporated in the EC are eligible. However, there is one sentence that makes me question this conclusion. Under the eligibility criteria, you have the sentence "Participation is also open to international organisations." Could you please let me know if my organization would be eligible to participate?	Participation is indeed open to international organizations, but please note they are defined as follows: International organizations: (a) international public-sector organisations set up by intergovernmental agreements, and specialised agencies set up by such organisations; (b) the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC); (c) the International Federation of National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies; (d) the European Investment Bank and the European Investment Fund.
